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## MATERIALS & TOOLS

Yarn 🎅 I used Schachenmayr Catania, Drops Alpaca and Rico Baby Teddy yarn.

Hooks 🎅 2,00mm, 2, 50mm and 3,00mm crochet hook or according to the yarn.

Polyester fiberfill for stuffing.

Safety eyes (8mm).

Yarn needle, sewing needle, scissors, stitch marker,

Wire (2,00mm) 18cm.

## NOTES

Work in continuous rounds (no joining required), do not join rounds or turn, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the end or the beginning of a round.


All stitches are worked into both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Stuff your doll as you go.




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**BODY**-With yarn A  - Stuff the body as you go.  
Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

3	*1 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	24 sc
4	*2 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	32 sc
5	*3 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	40 sc
6	*4 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	48 sc
7	*5 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	56 sc
8	1 sc in each stitch around	56 sc
9	*6 sc, 1 inc* 8 times	64 sc
10-20	(11 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	64 sc
21	*14 sc, 1 dec* 4 times	60 sc
22	1 sc in each stitch around	60 sc
23	*8 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	54 sc
24-25	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	54 sc
26	*7 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	48 sc
27	1 sc in each stitch around	48 sc
28	*4 sc, 1 dec* 8 times	40 sc
29	1 sc in each stitch around	40 sc
30	*3 sc, 1 dec* 8 times	32 sc
31-32	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	32 sc
33	*2 sc, 1 dec* 8 times	24 sc
34-36	(3 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	24 sc

**DO NOT** cut the yarn. Stuff the remaining body and the neck with fiberfill and continue with the head.

**HEAD**-With yarn A  - Stuff the head as you go.  
Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

37	*1 sc, 1 inc* 12 times	36 sc
38	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc
39	3 sc, 1 inc, *6 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 3 sc	48 sc
40	*7 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	54 sc


**41** 4 sc, 1 inc, \*8 sc, 1 inc\* 5 times, 4 sc 60 sc


**42-47** (6 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around 60 sc


**48** \*1 dec, 3 sc\* 3 times, 1 dec, 2 sc, \*1 dec, 3 sc\* 3 times, 1 dec, 24 sc 52 sc


Mark with a piece of yarn the 10<sup>th</sup> and the 19<sup>th</sup> stitches on round 48 to insert the safety eyes later.


**49-56** (8 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around 52 sc



 Insert the safety eyes on 10<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> stitches of round 48 (the space between them is 6 stitches).


 Sew the lashes using thinner dark brown yarn.

 Sew a white line to the sides of the eyes.

 With a thinner black yarn embroider a line under the eyes.

 Embroider the eyebrows with brown embroidery thread.

 With yarn B  sew the nose (3 stitches) in the middle of the eyes on round 46.

 Using dark brown yarn, sew a few stitches for the mouth on round 41.

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.  
Weave in the yarn tail through the front loops of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Make a knot and hide the remaining yarn tail.

#### GLAZE-With yarn C - Crochet hook 2,00mm.

Ch 80. Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the glaze onto the head.

Pin the glaze and sew it onto the head as the picture shows.

#### ARMS-With yarn A - Stuff the arms lightly as you go. Crochet hook 2,50mm.

1	8 sc in magic ring	8 sc
2	*1 sc, 1 inc* 4 times	12 sc
3	*2 sc, 1 inc* 4 times	16 sc
4	1 sc in each stitch around	16 sc

5	3 dec, 10 sc	13 sc
6	3 dec, 7 sc	10 sc
7-24	(18 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	10 sc
25	*dec* 5 times	5 sc

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.  
Weave in the yarn tail through the front loops of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.  
Make a knot and leave a yarn tail long enough to sew the arms to the body.

#### GLAZE-With yarn C - Crochet hook 2,00mm.

Ch 20. Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the glaze onto the arms.

Pin the glaze and sew it onto the arms as the picture shows.



#### LEGS-With yarn A - Crochet hook 2,50mm.

Begin with ch 6.

1	Start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 inc, 3 sc, [3 sc] into last chain, crochet down the other side of the chain 4 sc, 1 inc	14 sc
2	2 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc	20 sc
3	*4 sc, 1 inc* 4 times	24 sc
4-5	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	24 sc
6	10 sc, 3 dec, 8 sc	21 sc
7	8 sc, 3 dec, 7 sc	18 sc
8	6 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc	15 sc
9	4 sc, 3 dec, 5 sc	12 sc
10-11	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	12 sc





12	*1 inc, 5 sc* 2 times	14 sc
13	*6 sc, 1 inc* 2 times	16 sc
14	5 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc	18 sc
15-20	(6 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	18 sc
21	*1 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	12 sc
22	*dec* 6 times	6 sc

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.

Weave in the yarn tail through the front loops of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.

Make a knot and leave a yarn tail long enough to sew the legs to the body.

#### GLAZE-With yarn C - Crochet hook 2,00mm.

Ch 25. Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the glaze onto the legs.

Pin the glaze and sew it onto the legs as the picture shows.



#### BUTTONS-With yarn F (Make two). Crochet hook 2,00mm.

In a magic ring 5 sc, join with a sl.st.

Fasten off. Pull the yarn tightly and draw the loop together, leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the buttons onto Gingy's body.

Repeat the same for the second button.

Sew the buttons onto the body as shown in the picture.

#### CHRISTMAS HAT

With yarn E  - Crochet hook 3,00mm

rnd		sts
1	Begin with ch 60 and join with a sl.st., to the first chain to create a circle.	60 sc

From now on your 1<sup>st</sup> stitch is where you slip stitched into earlier. Start each round with chain 1 and close it with a slip stitch through the first stitch. **DO NOT** count them as stitches.

2-3	(2rnds) ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a slip stitch.	60 sc
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With yarn D  - Crochet hook 2,50mm

4-11	(8 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	60 sc
12	Ch 1, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, *1 dec, 8 sc* 4 times, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, join with a sl.st.	54 sc
13-18	(6 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st	54 sc
19	Ch 1, *4 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc* 6 times, join with a sl.st.	48 sc
20	Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	48 sc
21	Ch 1, 3 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, *1 dec, 6 sc* 4 times, 3 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, join with a sl.st.	42 sc
22	Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	42 sc
23	Ch 1, *3 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc* 6 times, join with a sl.st.	36 sc
24	Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st	36 sc
25	Ch 1, 2 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, *1 dec, 4 sc* 4 times, 2 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, join with a sl.st.	30 sc
26-27	(2 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	30 sc



<b>28</b>	Ch 1, *2 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc* 6 times, join with a sl.st.	24 sc
<b>29-32</b>	(4 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	24 sc
<b>33</b>	Ch 1, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, *1 dec, 2 sc* 4 times, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, join with a sl.st.	18 sc
<b>34-37</b>	(4 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	18 sc
<b>38</b>	Ch 1, *1 sc, 1 dec* 6 times, join with a sl.st.	12 sc
<b>39-42</b>	(4 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	12 sc
<b>43</b>	Ch 1, *2 sc, 1 dec* 2 times, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, join with a sl.st.	9 sc
<b>44-47</b>	(4 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	9 sc
<b>48</b>	4 dec, 1 sc	5 sc

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.  
Weave in the yarn tail through the front loops of  
each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.  
Make a knot and hide the remaining yarn tail.

With yarn E make a pom-pom and sew it on  
the top of the Christmas hat.



**CANDY**-With yarn B - Stuff the candy as you  
go. Crochet hook 2,50mm

<b>rnd</b>		<b>sts</b>
<b>1</b>	10 sc in magic ring	10 sc
<b>2-45</b>	(44 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	10 sc
<b>46</b>	*dec* 5 times	5 sc

Use wire (2,00mm) 18cm and bend it as shown in  
the picture. Put the wire into the candy. Stuff the  
candy very lightly so it keeps its shape.  
Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.  
Weave in the yarn tail through the front loops of  
each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Make  
a knot and hide the remaining yarn tail.

With yarn C Ch 100. Crochet hook 2,50mm.  
Wrap the chain around the candy, pin it and lastly  
sew it as shown in the pictures.




**HOLLY LEAF**-With yarn G (Make two).  
Crochet hook 2,00mm.

Begin with chain 11.  
Start in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 sl.st., 1 sc, [1 hdc,  
ch 2, 1 hdc], 2hdc, [1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc], 1 dc, 2 hdc,  
[1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc], crochet down the other side of the  
chain, 2 hdc, 1 dc, [1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc], 2 hdc, [1 hdc,  
ch 2, 1 hdc], 1 sc, 2 sl.sts.  
Fasten off, sew the two leaves together as the  
picture shows.



For the **berries** make 3 French knots.

To make French knots, bring a needle up through the leaf where you want the knot to be.

Wrap yarn **B**  around the needle three times and insert the needle back into the leaf very close to the hole you came out of. Slowly pull the needle through the wrapped loops to complete the French knot.

### ASSEMBLY OF THE GINGERBREAD



Sew the arms onto round 33 of the body.



Sew the legs between rounds 11-12 of the body.



Sew the glaze onto the head, the arms and the legs.



Sew the pom-pom on the top of the beanie.



Sew the holly leaves onto the candy.



Sew the buttons onto the body.



Put a little bit of blush on the cheeks.
